Directions to DARA

(May Meeting Only)

Please note: The May meeting only will be in Building 7 Room 006 B and Parking will be in the Visitor/Student Garage (Lot A). We will have parking passes available for all who park in Lot A. Lot A is accessible from Fifth Street, just east of Robert Street. Park on the 3rd floor and walk through the *West Walkway* (connector across Fourth Street) to Building 3. Buildings 3 through 7 are all connected and you can walk through them sequentially to Building 7. Room 006 B is on the lower level of Building 7. It is a relatively short walk and we will have DARA representatives along the path in key locations to make sure you don't get lost. See attached campus map.

From I-75:

- Take the Third Street Exit (53A)
- Turn East onto Third Street
- Turn right (approximately 1/4 mile off I-75)
- Turn right on Mead Street (3 blocks from Third Street)
- Turn right into Lot A

From SR-35:

- Take I-75 North to the Third Street Exit (53A)
- Follow above directions From I-75

From Northbound SR-48 (Main Street):

- Turn left onto Sixth Street
- Turn left onto Fourth Street
- Turn left onto Perry Street
- Turn right on Mead Street (3 blocks from Third Street)
- Turn right into Lot A

From Southbound SR-48 (Main Street):

- Turn right onto Monument Avenue
- Turn left onto Perry Street
- Turn right on Mead Street (6 blocks)
- Turn right into Lot A
